The iconic **Village of Cooperstown** is famous for the **Baseball Hall of Fame**, but there are so many more things to see and enjoy. Upon arrival we will visit the **Fly Creek Cider Mill**, one of Cooperstown's 'best kept secrets'. Shop and enjoy the wide range of unique foods, enjoy free samples and a taste of freshly pressed cider before enjoying lunch (on own). Afterwards, we visit the **Fenimore Art Museum** which holds important collections of American Folk Art, fine photography and American Indian Art. We will check into our hotel for two nights - **The Best Western Inn & Suites**, to freshen up before dinner at the **Lake Front Restaurant** on the docks of **Lake Otsego**. On Day 2, we spend our morning at **The Baseball Hall of Fame**. Trace the history of our national pastime, view artifacts and learn the stories of the fabled players throughout the years such as Red Sox players David Ortiz, Ted Williams, Carl Yastrzemski and Pedro Martinez. At lunchtime you can stroll Main Street where there are several restaurants, boutiques and baseball stores selling custom bats, cards and jerseys. We can also enjoy Lake Front Park or watch a game at Doubleday Field. Later this afternoon we enjoy a relaxing Cruise on Lake Otsego aboard **The Glimmerglass Queen**. We return to the hotel to freshen up before dinner at the **Brooks House of BBQ**. On Day 3 we will check-out and visit **The Farmers Museum**, a living history museum that recreates rural life in upstate New York circa 1845. We follow this with a lovely wine tasting at the **Montezuma Winery** to savor 6 samples of their favorite wines. Our final stop will be the 5-star **Otesaga Resort** on the lake where we enjoy a sumptuous **buffet lunch** and panoramic views.
